SAINT OF THE WEEK

St. Simeon the Stylite - September 1
As a thirteen-year-old shepherd of Turkey, Simeon heard a Gospel reading of the Beatitudes that greatly affected him. Entering a nearby monastery, he learned all the Psalms by heart and began to manifest that extraordinary spirit of self-denial. Thereafter Simeon lived as a hermit. His reputed miracle working generated many crowds. To escape the people, he began a pillar life remaining atop a column starting at 6 feet and later extended to 50 feet. Simeon remained atop the column until his death in 459, permanently exposed to the elements. Eventually his pillar became a pilgrim site. Visitors sought spiritual counsel, relief from sickness, and enlightened prayer. Simeon converted many people. He was called the "great wonder of the world."
