St. Patrick's and The Mother's Shrine has been designated by Bishop Gaydos as a special place of prayer for pilgrims during the **Holy Year of Mercy which ends Sunday, Nov., 20th.**

This Mercy Minute is the final reflection that closes out the Year of Mercy. The Pope's encyclical designating this past year as the "Year of Mercy" does not, however, want our attention to mercy to end with the calendar. It was meant to inspire each of us as Catholics, as Christians, as humans, to treat one another with the same mercy that God shows throughout the Bible. We are not to judge, hold grudges, bear anger, seek vengeance, or hate. We are in all our days and in all our ways to accept, forgive, forget, turn the other cheek, and love. May celebrating this Year of Mercy make us all more merciful and more attentive to the way we interact with each other.

PRAYER: God of Mercy, create in us loving, merciful hearts, that we may show mercy to all as you have shown mercy to us. Amen

SAINT OF THE WEEK

SAINT CECILIA- November 22

Although Cecilia is one of the most famous of the Roman martyrs, the stories of her are not founded on authentic material. According to legend, she was a young Christian of high rank betrothed to a Roman named Valerian. She is said to have been quite close to God and prayed often. Cecilia died a few days after her husband and his brother were beheaded for refusing to sacrifice to the gods. Her association with music stems from the story that at her wedding feast she sang to God in her heart.

St. Cecilia is regarded as the patroness of music. She is represented in art with an organ or organ pipes in her hand. May we too honor God by raising our voices in song when we worship. Good music is an integral part of the liturgy.
